1. Read John 14: 1-31.
2. What bold claim does Jesus make about himself in verse 6?
3. Why does this sort of claim often make people uncomfortable?
4. How might we proclaim and embody the significant message found in verse 6 in a way that is humble and faithful to the example Jesus set for us?
5. Who is the other helper that Jesus promises the Father will send the disciples when he's gone, and what will this helper do? (verses 16-17)
6. In what way have you experienced or witnessed the presence of the Spirit in your life or in the lives of others around you?
7. What remarkable promise about prayer does Jesus make in verses 13-14?
8. How does this promise challenge the way that we pray?
9. In verse 27, Jesus says, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives.....".

Why is the world unable to give us the kind of peace Jesus speaks of?

10. Can you think of an example of a time when you have experienced the peace that comes with the presence of Jesus?
